

Competition Sequence

The Competition will consist of three rounds :-

General Rules

STREET PLAY (NUKKAD NATAK)

Rules regarding Nukkad Natak

1. Teams should keep the time limit in mind. Exceeding the time limit will lead to disqualification.

- 1» The topic will be provided on the spot by the judges.
- 2» The contestants shall be given five (5) minutes to prepare and five (5) minutes to deliver.
- 3» The contestants are not allowed to have any gadget.
- 4» A timer accessible to the contestant, judges and audience shall be provided.
- 5» The contest master is accountable to the sanctification of the competition.
- 6» There will be a 1-point deduction for every 30-second overtime from the respective judges' total score before determining the rank of the contestants.
- 7» Use of sound effects, microphones and props is disallowed.
- 8» After the deliberation of the members of the board of judges, the judges' decision is final.
- 9» The style of the delivery shall be conversational, oratorical or a combination of both. Dramatic style of delivery may be disqualified.
- 10» In the case of a tie, the winner will be decided by the panel of judges by mutual discussion.

CLIENT COUNSELLING

The following rules and regulations shall govern the competition :-

Team Composition

- Each team must consist of two participants only.
- The two participants must be bonafide students of a Law college
- Teams should not be alter their composition after registration.

Competition Format

- Each team will participate in only one counseling session.
- Each counseling session is divided into three parts:
 - Consultation
 - Post consultation
 - Critique

Consultation:

- The consultation period shall be for 12 minutes.
- The time period will start from the moment the client enters the chamber.
- The time period is meant to be used for inter alia consultation with the client during which participants are expected to elicit the relevant information, outline the problem, find the clients expectations and propose a solution or other means of resolving the problem.
- During the consultation and post consultation, the team may use books, notes and other materials, the team may also use basic office props (files, desktop, furnishings, calendar, water etc.) and any other material to furnish their consultation room or for other relevant purposes.
- The time period is to be strictly adhered to but the judges may, in case of any reasonable circumstances provide an extra one minute to the team after which the client would necessarily leave and the post consultation period would begin.

- If the extended consultation session allowed an opportunity for a team to gather more information than other teams, this circumstance should be taken into consideration by the judges in making their decision.
- Judges may, at their discretion, penalize teams that allow the session to run longer than the stipulated time period.

Post Consultation

- In the post consultation period the participants may talk to each other loudly so as to be audible to the judges or may indirectly address them in any other manner.
- Participants may summarise the interview, indicate the scope of the legal work to be undertaken, and state the legal issues that should be researched. Explanation of the position or attitude taken by the students may be useful.
- If the students feel that some documents are appropriate, like a letter to the client confirming their retention as attorneys, the fee arrangement etc, or a letter to opposing counsel or to the party with whom the client is having their legal problems etc, they may dictate such a document at the post consultation stage.
- The time period for post consultation is 3 minutes.
- At the completion of the time period of post – consultation the judges shall stop the participants or signal them to stop in an obvious manner.
- Failure of the participants to comply with the above rule will attract negative marking.

Critique

After the completion of the post consultation period the judges may question the participants on matters deliberated upon or mentioned by the participants or the client during the consultation of post – consultation period.

The judges may ask any question which they considered material and questions meant to test the participants understanding of the facts and/ or law applicable or applied by the participants in the participants in the case.

The time period for this session is 3 minutes and the judges may extend it by another 2 minutes at their discretion.

Application Law

The problem will be based upon basic law of contract. Students can also give suggestions regarding mediation and arbitration.

Schedule

The teams have to report at 11am sharp at Sage University, Bhopal.

Uniform

The teams are supposed to wear their uniform or formal attire. (preferably **Black and White**)

LEGAL DUMBCHARDES

RULES FOR SOLO AND GROUP DANCE COMPETITION

Solo Dance

- Duration of performance: **5 minutes**. Exceeding the time may lead to a deduction in marks

- Group Participants should be minimum of 2 & maximum of 5 participants.
- Duration of performance: **5 minutes**. Exceeding the time may lead to a deduction in marks.
- Follow the uploaded guidelines to share the performance video.
- Use of vulgar, sexually explicit or violent language and/or lyrics is strictly prohibited.
- Judgment is based on the basis of rhythm, formation, expression, costumes, makeup, sets on the overall effect.

Solo Song

- The participants will be judged on the **Theme of 2022 of SAGE LAWGICAL LAW FEST** -FOLK/PATRIOTIC”

- The participant will be judged on song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- Time allotted for each performance is **5 minutes**.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.
- Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.

GROUP SONG

POETRY

- 1) Only one poem per person, per household is allowed.
- 2) Please keep a copy of the registration fee receipt.
- 3) Poetry can be written in any poetic style and on any subject.
- 4) The Poem can be in English or Hindi.
- 5) Poem must adhere to basic rules of capitalization:
 - a. *Do not type poem in all capital letters.*
 - b. *Do not capitalize the first letter of every word.*
 - c. *Only capitalize words that are proper (i.e. names and places).*
 - d. *The first word of each line may be capitalized if it is done consistently throughout.*
- 6) Under no circumstances can alterations be made to poems once entered.
- 7) A poem in its entirety must be an original work by the person entering the contest.
- 8) The deadline for submitting an entry is **21st December, 2022.**
- 9) The Max word limit for the Poem is 150.
- 10) Do not use “texting” lingo. Properly spell out all words and numbers.
- 11) Contest entries are judged based on poetic technique, effectiveness, style, and creativity

- 12) Poems containing language that is vulgar, unparliamentary, offensive, or wholly inappropriate will not be accepted.
 - 13) To ensure proper lineation, please use the “Enter” key to start a new line, indicating all intentional line breaks.
 - 14) Do not include your name or any other information at the end of your poem.
