
# AWARDS ARE A MOTIVATIONAL TOOL THAT KEEPS YOU GOING



## Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam

"Don't take rest after your first victory because if you fail in second, more lips are waiting to say that your first victory was just luck."



An aerospace scientist, and politician who served as the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. He studied physics and aerospace engineering and spent four decades as a scientist and science administrator, at the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). He was involved in India's civilian space program and military missile development efforts. He thus came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missile and launch vehicle technology. He also played a pivotal organizational, technical, and political role in India's Pokhran-II nuclear tests in 1998, the first since the original nuclear test by India in 1974.

Dr. Kalam will be always remembered for his passion and love for science, technology, and innovation. His contributions have enabled scientists, educationists, and writers across the globe, and instilled courage in people who look up to him to dream and achieve extraordinary things in life despite all limitations and circumstances.

#### Women Empowerment and Judiciary in India






#### Value of Mentorship
