

Conclave 2023

The SAGE School of Journalism and Mass Communication hosted a National Media Conclave on November 4, 2023. The event brought together industry experts, students, and academicians to explore recent trends of today's journalism. Dr. Vanya Chaturvedi and Mr. Mahendra Joshi hosted the inaugural ceremony with an emphasis on media's role in nurturing society.

During the inaugural session, a renowned journalist Mr. Abhilash Mishra (Executive Editor, NEWS24) offered unique insights on experiences gained through technological interference and their new life lessons. The keynote speaker of the session Mr. Saurabh Dwivedi Founder Editor, The Lallantop, discussed media's power in addressing critical issues, focusing on Adivasi education. He also put an emphasis on the importance of dialogue in effective journalism. Mr. N. Raghuraman highlighted the value of hard work and reader-focused journalism as a dire necessity of time. Dr. V.K. Jain Honorable Vice Chancellor, SAGE University Bhopal, spoke on media's influential role in shaping a nation.

The conclave further proceeded through three insightful plenary sessions. 
Crime Scene Investigation

Apple sets sight on Rs 1 lakh crore milestone in India this fiscal year



Technology giant Apple is targeting a production milestone of nearly Rs 1 lakh crore worth of iPhones in India for the fiscal year ending March 2024, reported The Economic Times. Officials familiar with the matter told the publication that the company has enhanced its manufacturing capacity, achieving over Rs 60,000 crore in production during the first seven months of the fiscal year. If Apple falls short of the 1 lakh-crore target by the end of this fiscal, it is anticipated to reach the milestone in the first quarter of FY25, the ET report added, quoting sources. To meet festive demand in the US and the West, Apple is gearing up for production. However, global headwinds, including a slowdown in consumption, pose challenges. Approximately 70 per cent of iPhones produced in India are exported. In the April to October period of this fiscal, Apple exported iPhones worth Rs 40,000 crore or \$5 billion, surpassing the total exports of the previous fiscal.

Apple's rapid growth in India

In FY23, iPhones became the first single brand to exceed \$5 billion in exports from India. Apple has witnessed a 185 per cent year-on-year (YoY) growth in exports during the first seven months of the current fiscal. It may be noted that Apple's production in India is carried out by manufacturing partners like Foxconn,

Pegatron, and Wistron, as part of the production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for smartphone manufacturing. These partners produce iPhone models ranging from 12 to 15. The Tata Group recently signed an agreement with Wistron to acquire a 100 per cent equity stake in Wistron to Infocom m Manufacturing (India) Pvt Ltd, making it the first Indian entity to officially join the Apple supply chain. Apple has

steadily increased its focus on India for iPhone manufacturing, testing the market from 2018-19 and scaling up its efforts from 2020-21. The company's manufacturing capacity has surged from Rs 16,750 crore in 2020-21 to Rs 60,000 crore in the first seven months of the current fiscal. Market observers anticipate that, in addition to exports, Apple is benefiting from the growing premiumisation trend in the Indian market. The company is projected to sell a record 9-10 million iPhones in India in 2024, compared to less than 7 million in 2023. Apple India's year-end turnover for FY23 reached Rs 49,321 crore, contributing 1.5 per cent to Apple's global turnover of Rs 32.6 lakh crore (\$383.93 billion), as per data from the Registrar of Companies.

Government may transfer unclaimed funds from Sahara-Sebi Refund Account

The government is examining the potential transfer of unclaimed funds from the Sahara-Sebi refund account to the Consolidated Fund of India, reported The Economic Times. Despite this consideration, provisions will be made to facilitate refunds for investors, added the report.



The report comes almost a week after the death of Sahara founder Subrata Roy, following which the focus on the Sahara-Sebi Refund Account intensified, although there have been minimal claimants over the decade since its establishment.


In 2012, the Supreme Court upheld a Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) order, instructing Sahara India Real Estate Corp and Sahara Housing Investment Corp to refund investors with interest, depositing the funds with the capital markets regulator. In the event that Sebi cannot locate the whereabouts of subscribers, the Supreme Court specified that the collected funds from such subscribers would be appropriated to the Government of India.

An official told the business daily that the government could explore the option of transferring the amount to the Consolidated Fund of India with a separate account for investor refunds. The official acknowledged that the dedicated refund account under Sebi has witnessed minimal claimants even 11 years after the judgment.

As of March 31 this year, the total recovered amount from the Sahara Group and deposited in state-run banks was Rs 25,163 crore. In March, Rs 5,000 crore was transferred to the Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies following a Supreme Court decision, specifically for legitimate dues of Sahara Group of Cooperative Societies. A dedicated portal was initiated for refunds. As per the latest order, the amount will be disbursed to depositors of the Sahara Group of Cooperative Societies from Rs 5,000 crore at the earliest, not later than nine months from the order date. Any remaining balance will be transferred to the Sahara-Sebi Refund Account. In July, Union Minister

Amit Shah launched a dedicated portal to streamline the refund process for Sahara depositors. It may be noted that the Sahara entities had raised funds through optionally fully convertible debentures, a move that Sebi deemed unauthorised, prompting the regulator to instruct Sahara to refund depositors.

Sotagliflozin provides kidney, heart-related benefits to patients



Patients with and without diabetes can benefit from sodium-glucose cotransporter -2 (SGLT2) inhibitors, which are drugs that, reduce blood sugar levels and improve heart and kidney function. The effects of sotagliflozin, a dual SGLT1 and 2 inhibitors, in individuals with type 2 diabetes and chronic kidney disease were recently discovered through anexploratory analysis. Sotagliflozin decreased the risk of the composite of persistent >=50 percent drop in estimated glomerular filtration rate, estimated glomerular filtration rate <15 mL/min/1.73m2, dialysis, or kidney transplant by 38 percent, the risk of a cardiorenal composite outcome (the previous composite plus mortality from cardiovascular disease or kidney disease) by 23 per cent. David Cherney, MD CM, PhD, FRCP(C))"Sotagliflozin is now FDA approved under the name 'INPEFA' to reduce the risk of cardiovascular death and heart failure events with a broad label that includes patients with heart failure or chronic kidney disease, so the drug is now an option for nephrologists and cardiologists, as well as primary care physicians, to prescribe."
