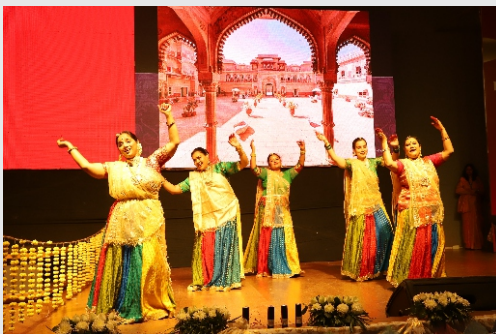

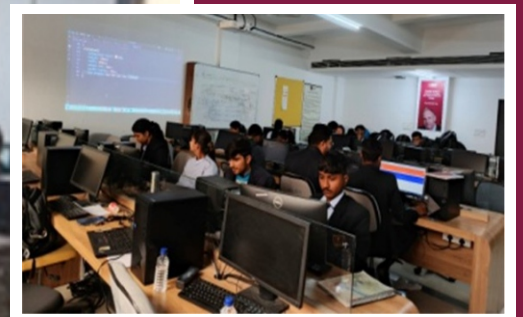
VAC on Herbal Roll On

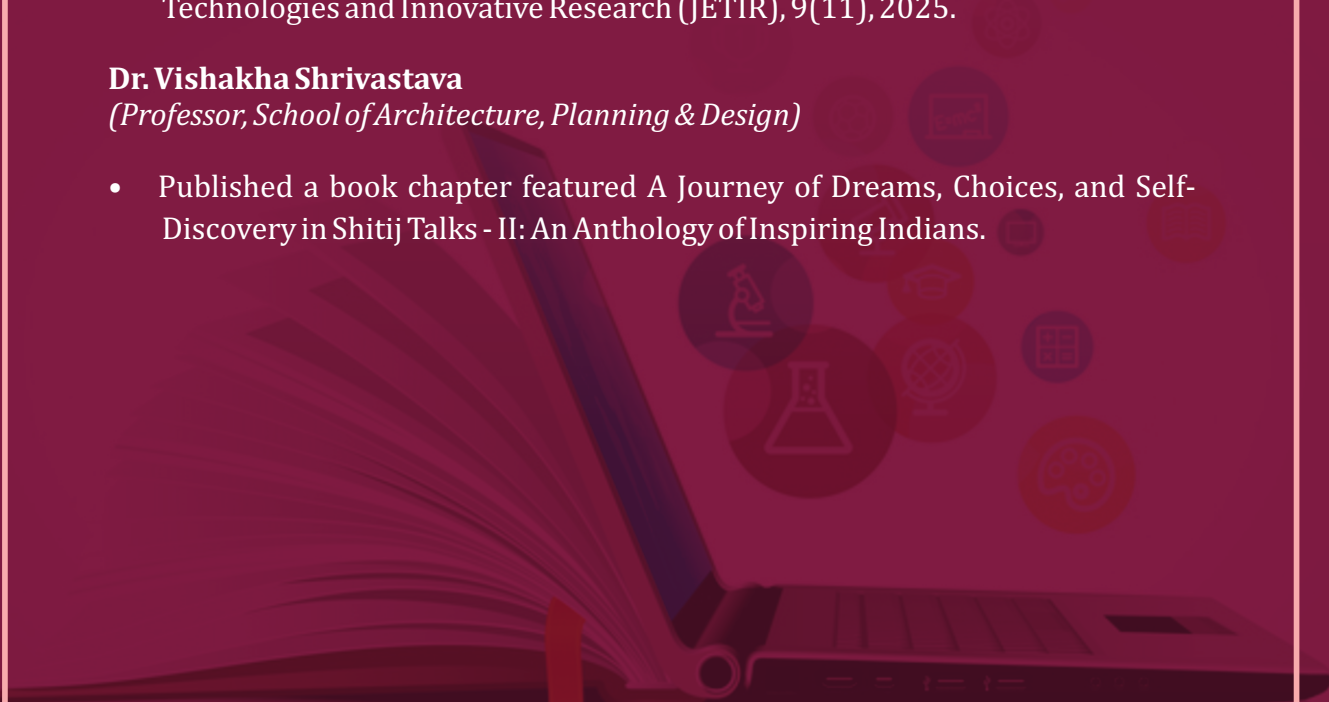
